

# Application & Removal Instructions

## YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 small container of warm soapy water
- 1 kitchen sponge
- 1 marker or pen
- 1 pair of sharp scissors or Stanley Knife
- 1 clean lint-free cloth
- 2 x plastic cards / credit cards

## PREPERATION

- 1) Wash the inside of the car window using warm, soapy water and a clean sponge.
- 2) Thoroughly dry with a clean lint-free cloth.
- 3) Place the toddler tint against the outside of the window, with the design facing the window and the protective backing facing you, **ensuring the design is the correct way up**. Lightly trace the outline of the window onto the backing sheet.
- 4) Cut away the excess toddler tint leaving a 2cm boarder around the traced line.

## APPLICATION

- 5) Starting at the bottom of the window, slowly peel away the backing sheet and stick the tint to the **inside of the window**. Lift and reapply the tint to remove any bubbles. Use your hands to smooth down the tint and press into corners.
- 6) Peel back small sections of the tint off the window and trim along your marked line.
- 7) Once you have trimmed around the entire tint, **use a plastic card to press it firmly back onto the window ensuring all edges and corners adhere firmly**. At the bottom of the window, it is preferable to push the tint below the window seal. The best way to do this is to use one card to gently pull back the seal and the second card to push the tint below the seal. If your window seal does not allow you to do this, we recommend you trim the tint so that it sits approximately 1cm above the seal.
- 8) Please allow 48hrs before winding the window down to allow it to dry.

## REMOVING TODDLER TINTS™

**Please note, once removed the toddler tint cannot be reused.**

Your toddler tint can be removed from your car window using hot soapy water and a kitchen sponge. First, make sure it is thoroughly wet and then leave for 5 minutes to allow the adhesion agent to react. Before attempting to remove, thoroughly wet the tint again and then start peeling from the base of the window. Slowly and gently move up towards the top of the window, using a sponge along the peel line to wet the adhesion agent. Repeating until entire tint is removed from your window.

## TODDLER TINTS™ TOP TIPS

- When applying, park your car in the shade and out of the wind.
- Do not use a solvent-based glass cleaner (such as Windex) prior to installation.
- If you have one, you may find it easier to use a Stanley Knife to trim around the edges (Step 6).
- Try to install your toddler tint at a time when you're not going to be interrupted by your little one. Tricky we know!
